——— The Tasman Peninsula is an easy scenic drive from Hobart. Rich in convict history, and well known for the World Heritage-listed Port Arthur Historic Site, this region has spectacular coastlines with some of the tallest sea cliffs in the world, blowholes, caves and wild ocean views.

How to get there

BY AIR Fly to Hobart.

BY CAR

Drive from Hobart for the day or stay longer. Allow approximately 1.5 hours to travel from Hobart to the Tasman Peninsula.

BY BUS/COACH

Travel by coach for a day tour to Port Arthur or as part of an extended itinerary. See the tours available through <u>Experience Tasmania</u> or the private coach hire at <u>Coal River Coaches</u>.

SEA-BASED ACTIVITIES

- Try the best fish and chips at the <u>Doo-lishus</u> food truck located in the car park at the Tasman blow hole.

- Step back in time with a visit to the world renowned <u>Port Arthur Historic Site</u>.
- Set aside three days to embark on the ultimate Tasman Peninsula walk, the <u>Three Capes Track</u>.



Where to stay

There is a wide variety of places to stay in and around the Tasman Peninsula. Some suggested accommodation include:

- Port Arthur Villas Set on 2 acres of garden and located across the road from Port Arthur Historic Site, this quality 4-star self-contained apartment accommodation provides a central base to explore the region. Enjoy short and long walks in the bush, or along the beach.
- Lufra Hotel and Apartments Located a short drive from Port Arthur there is a choice of hotel rooms or self-contained apartments, with an onsite restaurant and café providing an ideal location to take in the views of Eaglehawk Neck.
- <u>Stewarts Bay Lodge</u> Nestled between a beautiful beach, a forest, the calming ocean, a world heritage listed national park and the Port Arthur Historic Site, there is a variety of quality selfcontained cabin and chalet accommodation. There is also a restaurant overlooking the water.
- <u>NRMA Port Arthur Holiday Park</u> Accommodation options include waterview cabins, glamping safari tents, bunkhouses perfect for groups, and ensuite and unpowered caravan sites and camping sites. Located 1 km north of Port Arthur.
